The California Community Foundation is dedicated to fostering collaboration across sectors in order to strengthen the communities of Los Angeles. As part of this commitment, the foundation established the Joan Palevsky Center for the Future of Los Angeles, a conference facility available for complimentary use by nonprofit organizations whose work is aligned with the mission of the California Community Foundation.

Centrally located in downtown Los Angeles, the Palevsky Center offers well-equipped, contemporary meeting space where diverse groups can gather to address the most serious issues and challenges facing the Los Angeles community today.

ELIGIBILITY

The Palevsky Center is available free of charge for nonprofit organizations whose work is aligned with the California Community Foundation's mission of strengthening Los Angeles communities through effective philanthropy and civic engagement. The center is envisioned as a place where diverse groups can gather together to advance positive social change, strengthen the nonprofit sector, and increase the understanding of philanthropy in Los Angeles.

FACILITIES

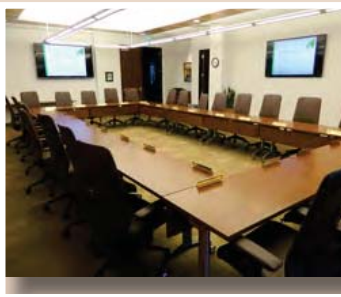
The Joan Palevsky Center consists of a central lobby surrounded by three rooms that can host groups ranging in size from six to 100 attendees. Wireless internet service is available throughout the space. Original artwork by Los Angeles artists from the permanent collection of CCF is on display throughout the center.

CONFERENCE ROOM



The Conference Room is a 2,600 square-foot multi-purpose room with a capacity of up to 100 guests. The space can be subdivided into three rooms with capacities of 18/22/60, depending on configuration. The room features five 60" flat screen video monitors connected to a computer for visual presentations, a sound system equipped with four wireless lavalier microphones and four wireless handheld microphones and a conference phone. The space is furnished with 50 moveable tables and 100 armless chairs, allowing for multiple configurations and easy re-arrangement.

BOARD ROOM



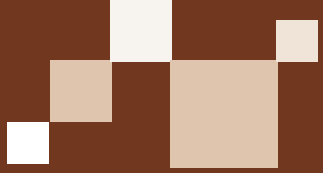
The Board Room seats up to 24 guests around an open square table and 10 additional in chairs around the room. The room is equipped with one 70" and one 80" flat screen video monitor connected to a computer, a voice amplification system and a conference phone. The furniture in this room is stationary and cannot be rearranged.

GREEN ROOM

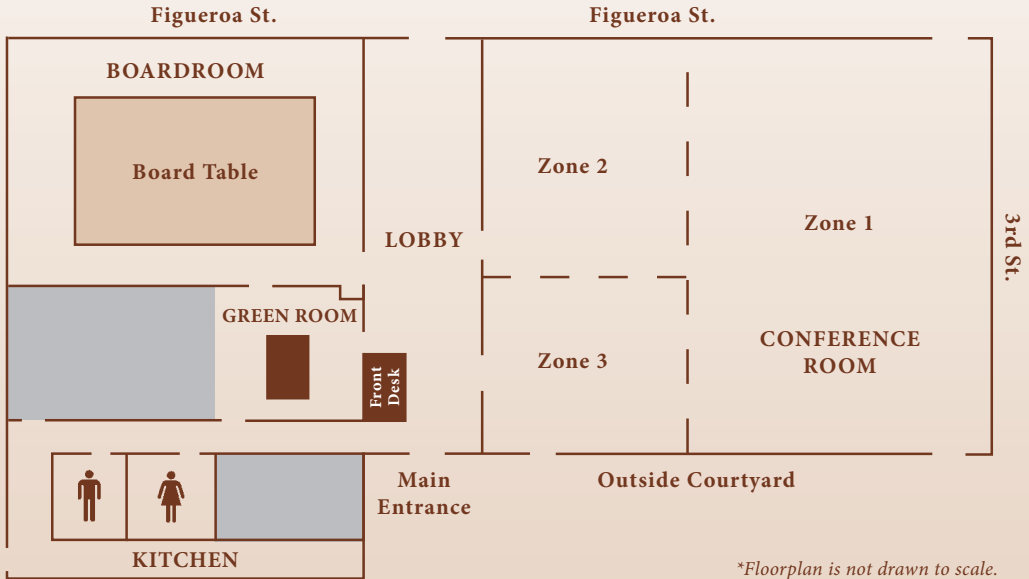


The Green Room is connected to the Board Room, and features a table that seats up to six guests, a buffet station, and a 60" video monitor. This space can double as a food and beverage service area.

The Palevsky Center also offers a catering kitchen, equipped with a sink, two refrigerators, two microwave ovens, two dishwashers, and a First Aid cabinet.
